

Baby Seed Jacket

Berocco Comfort
Needles – US size 4/3.5mm

Small size – newborn-3 mos (1 skein)
Larger size – 6-9 mos (2 skeins)

Back

Cast on 43 (51)

Work seed stitch for 12 rows.

Next row: P1, K1, P1, knit to last 3 stitches, P1, K1, P1

Next row: P1, K1, P1, purl to last 3 stitches, P1, K1, P1

Repeat these 2 rows until piece measures 5 (6) inches then start raglan shaping.

Next row: Bind off 2 stitches, knit to last 3 stitches, P1, K1, P1.

Next row: Bind off 2 stitches, purl to end

Next row: K1, K2tog, knit to last 3 stitches, SSK, K1

Next row: Purl

Repeat the last 2 rows until 21 (27) stitches remain. Put remaining stitches on a holder.

Right Front

If you care about whether your jacket buttons to the right or the left, just switch which side you put the buttonholes on. The 2 front pieces are mirror images.

Cast on 29 (35) stitches and work 12 rows of seed stitch.

Next row: (K1, P1) x5, knit to last 2 stitches, P1, K1

Next row: K1, P1, purl to last 10 stitches, (P1, K1)x5

Repeat these 2 rows until piece measures 3 (4) inches then work first row of button holes.

Buttonhole row 1: K1, P1, yo, P2tog, K1, P1, K1, yo, K2tog, p1, knit to last 2 stitches, P1, K1

Buttonhole row 2: K1, purl to last 10 stitches, work in seed stitch pattern to end.

(The second row of buttonholes should be worked in the same way 12 rows after the first set of buttonholes.)

Work in pattern until piece measures 5(6) inches, then start raglan shaping.

Raglan row 1: Work seed stitch panel then knit to last 2 stitches, P1, K1

Raglan row 2: Next row: Bind off 2 stitches, purl to last 10 stitches, work seed stitch pattern



Print in **RED** is errata from the original pattern.

Raglan row 3: Work seed stitch panel then knit to last 3 stitches, SSK, K1
Raglan row 4: Purl to last 10 stitches, work seed stitch pattern

Repeat the last 2 rows until 20(24) stitches remain.

Bind off until 7 stitches remain, K4, SSK, K1

Next row: Purl

Next row: K1, K2tog, SSK, K1

Next row: Purl

Next row: K1, SSK, K1

Next row: Purl

Next row: Slip 2 stitches as if to knit, K1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knit stitch.

Cut yarn and pull the end through.

Left Front

If you care about whether your jacket buttons to the right or the left, just switch which side you put the buttonholes on. The 2 front pieces are mirror images.

Cast on 29 (35) stitches and work 12 rows of seed stitch.

Next row: K1, P1, knit to last 10 stitches, (P1, K1) x5,

Next row: (K1, P1)x5, purl to last 2 stitches, K1, P1

Repeat these 2 rows until piece measures 5 (6) inches, then start raglan shaping.

Raglan row 1: Bind off 2 stitches, knit to last 10 stitches, work seed stitch panel

Raglan row 2: Work seed stitch panel then purl to end

Raglan row 3: K1, K2tog, knit to last 10 stitches, work seed stitch panel

Raglan row 4: Work seed stitch panel, purl to end

Repeat the last 2 rows until 20(24) stitches remain.

Neck row 1: K1, K2tog, knit to last 10 stitches.

Neck row 2: Bind off 20 stitches, P6

Next row: K1, K2tog, SSK, K1

Next row: Purl

Next row: K1, SSK, K1

Next row: Purl

Next row: Slip 1 stitches as if to knit, K2tog, pass the slipped stitch over the K2tog.

Cut yarn and pull the end through.

Sleeves (make 2)

Sleeves are worked from the top down.

Cast on 5 (7) stitches. Increase 1 stitch each side until sleeve matches back and sides, ending on a wrong side row. Before turning, cast on 2 stitches. Purl the row, casting on 2 stitches at the end of the row.

Work even for 6 rows.
Knit 1, K2tog, knit to last 3 stitches, SSK, K1.
Purl.
Knit.
Purl.
Knit.
Purl.

Repeat these 6 rows two more times.

Work even in stockinette stitch until the sleeve measures 7 (9) inches.

Work in seed stitch for 10 rows. Loosely bind off.

Sew sleeves to back section then sew sleeves to each of the front sections. Starting at underarm, sew the sleeve seam then start at the underarm to sew side seams.

Collar

Starting at middle of seed panel and working to sleeve, pick up 14 (19) stitches, then 2 stitches from top of sleeve, then 21 (28) stitches from back, then 2 stitches from top of sleeve, then 14 (19) stitches from sleeve to middle of seed panel.

Work seed stitch for 18 rows. Bind off loosely

Once the jacket is put together, overlap the seed panels in the front with the one with buttonholes on top. Sew the buttons to the bottom layer to match the buttonholes.

Sew snaps at the neckline as needed.

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
